This Federally funded project, STP-C00S (493) construction, NJDOT Job. No. 5808380, consisted of the rebuilding/replacement of the Camden County Pearl Street Bulkhead from Marina Drive to the Delaware River. All services during construction were performed to meet Federal aid and NJDEP permit and inspection requirements from the pre-construction meeting through the final inspection. The project included a construction duration of 60 days, mitigation for 30 days, and limited part-time closeout services for 60 days.

The scope of work included:

- Guiderail installation
- Steel sheet pile and cap construction
- Soil stabilization and wetlands planting
- Maintenance and protection of traffic(MPT) and pedestrians
- Turbidity barrier Installation for soil erosion control and protection of anadromous fish species
- Concrete curb installation
- Roadway reconstruction
- Buy America compliance
- Federal Aid reimbursement/coordination of oversight inspections with NJDOT South Region
- NJDEP Waterfront Development In-water Individual Permit (IP)

The project was constructed on time and under budget.
