The South Jersey Transportation Authority (SJTA) continues to provide the traveling public with safe and efficient transportation through the construction, maintenance, operation and support of expressway, airport, transit, parking, and other transportation projects and services. As the General Engineering Consultant (GEC) for the SJTA, Remington & Vernick Engineers was tasked with providing project management services during the design phase of the project and then construction management and inspection services during all construction activities.

The scope of the project entailed approximately 2000 SF of building addition and 1000 SF of renovation to the existing building to maximize space and function for traffic operations, communications personnel and State Police. Work included replacement of the existing roof, mechanical, electrical and plumbing improvements, a new emergency generator, new workstations, network equipment, a video display wall and relocation of existing ITS and dispatch equipment.

Project management services were provided during the design phase. This included revising previously prepared documents to secure the necessary NJDCA permits and advertise for construction bids. The firm acted as the Project Manager to the SJTA, monitoring the schedule and projects costs. A QA/QC review of prepared documents was performed.

Construction management services were performed, including on-site field inspection and contract administration. Included monitoring of the schedule and ensuring all construction is completed in accordance with the plans and specifications, and to the complete satisfaction of the SJTA and New Jersey State Police.
